Knee-High Wildflower Mix

This popular flower mixture is composed of annuals and perennials that are generally two foot tall at maturity. It is especially suitable for residential or commercial landscaping.

This mix will adapt to the region it's planted in.

Seeding rate: 5-7oz/1,000 sq. ft. 8-16lbs/Acre
